If you answered yes to the questions above, then why volunteer in the YES Forum for a long-term EVS?

The volunteer will join the team of the YES Forum Secretariat in Stuttgart, Germany, one of the leading European networks in the field of Youth and Social Work. Depending on current international project, the volunteer will also get the opportunity to travel to project meetings and other YES Forum events throughout Europe.

The volunteer will work **30 hours per week**, which includes also the German language course and other training activities relating to the EVS. The working language is English.

Furthermore, the volunteer will also have time and space for initiating activities in an area of special interest. However, this needs to be matching the organisation's mission and work.

Length: 9 months – 1 year

The **tasks** will be mainly related to:

- Liaising with YES Forum members
- Assisting in on-going projects in which the YES Forum is involved (e.g. youth exchanges and other transnational mobility opportunities for young people), e.g. drafting reports
- Assisting in the organisation of YES Forum events and conferences (e.g. the YES Forum General Assembly, Project Planning Meeting), e.g. drafting invitations, being in contact with registered participants, providing information and being responsible for registrations etc.
- Assisting in daily administrative tasks
- Contributing to the bi-monthly newsletter, updating the organisations' website, social media marketing, including Facebook and Twitter

Profile of the volunteer:

- Between 18 and 30 years old
- Fluent in English
- Responsible, enthusiastic, and creative

The YES Forum **provides** the volunteer with:

- One return travel ticket between the sending country and Germany up to the approved travel grant;
- Assistance in locating accommodation and the covering of rent expenses;
- A monthly food allowance (229 EUR) and monthly pocket money (110 EUR);
- Health insurance within the ERASMUS+ programme;
- Local public transportation monthly pass;
- Assistance in securing German language courses.
